The Bachelor of Aviation (Flight Operations) prepares you for a career as a professional airline pilot. Studied over three years, you will learn the aeronautical theory required to gain your Commercial Pilot Licence and the Air Transport Pilot Licence theory component.

In combination with your current studies in our Bachelor of Aviation, you can enrol in our Graduate Diploma of Aviation (Flight Operations) to begin your flight training. To enrol in this course, you will need to successfully hold a Class 1 CASA Aviation Medical, current red Australian Security Identification Card, ICAO ELP level 6, and be approved by CQ University's Head of Course.

CLXX- GRADUATE DIPLOMA OF AVIATION (FLIGHT OPERATIONS)

The Graduate Diploma of Aviation (Flight Operations) is studied concurrently with the Bachelor of Aviation and will provide you with the aeronautical experience required for a career as a commercial pilot.

You will build your skills as a pilot with Flight Standards starting with short flights right through to commercial pilot licence level.
